## Conference Committees

Committee	Description
<b>NNSTOY Ambassadors</b>	The Ambassadors Committee serves to make partners/sponsors, new conference attendees, and presenters feel welcome. The Ambassadors may be assigned to a specific group of people and be their conference "buddy" and answer any questions.
<b>NNSTOY University Credit</b>	The NNSTOY University Credit Committee will partner with local colleges and districts to offer continuing ed credits for attending the conference.
<b>Social Events</b>	The Social Events Committee is responsible for planning the receptions (food and entertainment) as well as the "Night on Your Own" in Las Vegas. The Social Committee will research venues in the JW Marriott for the receptions and provide a "one pager" of different Las Vegas options for the "Night on Your Own."
<b>Day of Service</b>	The Day of Service Committee is responsible for planning the service day. This sub-committee should plan where the DOS will occur, the time frames, and the transportation. Members of the Day of Service will serve as point of contact before, during, and after the Day of Service.
<b>Presenters</b>	The Presenter Committee will reach out to non-STOY and NNSTOY speakers who can speak to one of our four problems of practice. The Committee will review RFPs and establish who will be speaking regarding each Problem of Practice.
<b>Communications</b>	The Communications Committee will work with Laurie Calvert to create social media cards, tweet decks, and other social media communications to be used before, during, and after the conference.
<b>Logistics</b>	The Logistics Committee will work with Lauren Cantell to choose menus, research transportation for Day of Service, help at the registration desk, assist with setting up the day before the conference.
<b>Scholarship Fund</b>	The Scholarship Fund Committee will communicate with the membership about bringing items from their state prior to the conference. During the conference, members of this committee will collect, display, and account for all donations. Committee members will also sell tickets and hold on to funds.
<b>Local Teacher Recruitment</b>	The Teacher Recruitment Committee will work with Clark County and surrounding districts to hear their problems of practice regarding teacher retention. This committee will seek to get involvement from Clark County and surrounding districts.
<b>Non-NNSTOY Outreach</b>	The Non-NNSTOY and Inactive Membership Involvement Committee will involve non-NNSTOY teachers and administrators via their districts and other networking events as well as reach out to inactive NNSTOY members including Finalists and retired teachers.
